Bring People to Christ: that God will draw them to salvation, reveal truth, and open the eyes of their understanding. (Jn 6:44; Jn8:32)


Unity of Believers: that we will love one another, let go of all bitterness & unforgiveness, & fully engage in God's will. (Jn.13:34;Eph.4:31)
