
When Do We Pray?



WHEN DO WE PRAY?

- In the morning. If you can, make a regular time in the morning to pray. Satisfy me in the morning with your unfailing love. (Ps.90:14)
- Find a day of the week to pray with one or two others as well. Pray in unity and agreement for the same things. You can do it on the phone or over coffee or even on a prayer walk. The accountability is essential to our health and healing.
- When we are with others, with relatives or even visiting a friend's house.
- Ask them if you can pray for them, our communities and nation. Be the blessing of God on them through it.
