WHAT DO WE PRAY?

We pray for the big things in the Christian walk, which we know are the will of God. Our nation, families and our own lives, need the blessings of God that come through prayer. If the nation does not have God's miraculous intervention, we may slowly lose our freedom of speech, religion, and to worship God freely.

The Word tells us what God's will is. These requests are prioritized in the Word of God. They are some big ones for our Christian walk and for our land.

"And we know that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us and if we know that He hears us we know that we have what we have asked of Him." 1 John 5:14

Pray for these requests, and you will God will find the blessings of God come. And

you invest in our nation as well. Seek first the kingdom of God and all these things will be added to you as well. Things are often established in prayer before we see them in the physical realm. We need to pray.

Take 1/2 an hour (30 minutes) a day to pray with us:

• **Repentance**: that we turn to God and love God with all our heart, mind and soul. Pray that there will be genuine repentance that will result in actions and behaviors that are sincere (the fruit of repentance). Mk 12:30,31; Mt. 3:8

How do we pray this? (one example): Heavenly Father, we thank you that You are with us. We ask that You bring repentance in the nation, in our communities and in our families, that more will turn to You and love You with all of our heart, mind and soul...

• **Salvation for the lost**: that the light of the gospel of Christ will shine on the lost; that God will draw them to salvation and reveal truth to them. Ask God to open the eyes of their understanding, to

realize their need for a Savior with clarity. Jn 3:16; Eph. 4:18

• Unity of believers: that we will love one another, let go of all bitterness and unforgiveness, be mission minded, have God's heart for others, and share the Gospel

and glory of Christ like a city set on a hill. Jn 17:21; Mk 12:31 $\,$

- A Mighty Outpouring of God's Spirit upon us: that we will be open to the ways He desires to work and that Times of Refreshing may come! Pray that a mighty revival will come through prayer and fasting. Pray that Jesus' Name will be glorified. Acts 2:17-18; Acts 3:19; Jn 17:1
- Confession of Sin: Confess the sin of the nation, personal and churches. Ask for God's mercy and forgiveness. 1 Jn.1:9
- **Leaders**: of the nation to be convicted of sin and righteousness and for this country to be turned upside down for the glory of God. (Jn 16:8)
- **Ministry:** that we will hear God's direction and follow His leading. (Eph. 6:19)
