Why Pray With Others?

For the Sake of our families, communities and nation. Our nation needs the hand of God. We need His ability to change the course of the nation.

There Is Power In Agreement. What were they doing in Acts 2 when the Day of Pentecost came? They were praying together. Throughout the Bible, God has often answered in amazing ways when his people gather together to pray and seek His face.

How To Pray With Others?

Pray with Grace (God's enablement). Pray from your heart, as led by the Holy Spirit. Pray through the requests on the brochure.

Take time to bless each other as well.

Take turns in prayer. Allow others to pray also. You can do "popcorn prayer" where you say shorter prayers and do a round robin. Or each person can pray in turn and pray longer prayers as you think of things.

Gather together. **Have coffee.**

Make the time to pray on your own as well. It will be worth it. Every Christian can pray 1/2 an hour a day.

If two of you agree on earth concerning anything that you ask, it will be done for them. Mt.18:19

Then when praying with others, decide on some time to do it. Find a day and time of the week to start. Set up a place and establish a routine that you like.

Start by praising God. Then pray through the requests. Take time for your own personal requests. Then you can end by thanking God.

For instance: God, I pray that You will work in our communities, families and nation, that we will love You first and make You the first priority in our lives. (This is the first request on the back side of the brochure).



Don't be as concerned about how you sound when you pray as much as praying from your heart, to the Lord. "Render your heart and not your garments." Joel 2:13

God brings Healing through it.

"Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed." James 5:16a



Prayer is not always to be alone. Here it is also to be done in groups of two or more. To pray for "each other" is important. We are to confess our sins to each other and pray for each other in order for healing to come.

Pray the requests on the next page for your communities, families, state and nation, that God's will is done and that we see change and revival!

Can you imagine a thousand people praying for the same thing consistently in your regions?

Take 1/2 an hour (30 minutes) a day to pray with us:

Repentance: that we turn to God and love God with all our heart, mind and soul. (Mt. 22:37; Acts 3:19)

Salvation for the lost: that God will send out laborers into the harvest field to draw people to Christ. (Lk 10:2)

Unity of believers: Ask God to heal & restore relationships; abounding in love. (Jms 5:16)

A Mighty Outpouring of God's Spirit: and that Times of Refreshing may come! (Joel 2:28-29; Acts 3:19)

Leaders: of the nation to be convicted of sin, righteousness & guilt as needed, and for godly decisions by regional and national leaders.

Confession of Sin: personal & national; and ask for God's mercy & forgiveness. (Ps.103:11-12)

Ministry: that we all use our gifts effectively and are led by the Spirit. (1 Cor.12:4; Ro.8:14)
