Praying the Will of God



Ask and you shall receive and your joy will be complete.

Jesus gave us an example in the Lord's Prayer (Matthew 6:9-13):

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name, Your kingdom come, Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

Ask for things that You know are God's will. What types of things are God's will?

There are two themes to this answer. One is the verse that speaks of asking for what we desire:

Delight yourself in the Lord and He will give you the desires of your heart.

Proverbs 37:4

The principle is first to delight ourselves in the Lord. Then your desires will be His desires. So ask for what you desire.

The second way to ask for God's will is to look at the Word of God. What does His

Word tell us to do? Pray for it. For example:

Pray for:

- 1. **Repentance, that all will turn to Christ** and make Him their Lord and Savior, that forgiveness and Times of Refreshing come from the Lord. (Acts 3:19)
- 2. **The Body of Christ** to be united, praying always, and mission minded for the glory of Christ (Matt.28:18-20;1 Cor. 1:10).
- 3. Willingness of heart to follow God wherever He leads. "Whom shall I send, and who will go for us?" Then I said, "Here am I! Send me." (Isaiah 6:8). It is still on the heart of God to find people who are willing to follow His call.

These are sample examples to start from.

If you ask anything according to my will, I will do it. 1Jn. 5:14

Give us each day our daily bread.

What is our daily bread? We ask for God's provision for our needs. Ask for what you need. It is God's will to supply it.



Together in prayer we can bring change!

A principle here is what Luke 6:38 says, "Give and it will be given to you." If we want to receive, we also must be willing to give.

Forgive us our sins, for we also forgive

everyone who sins against us.

The condition is that we also forgive others. So, ask God if



there are any people that you need to forgive. Then, ask God to help you forgive, and give you a willingness of heart to do so.

And God is able to make all grace about to you so that in all things, at all times you have all that you need... 2 Cor. 9:7

And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.

Ask God to protect you from temptation and break strongholds that are on you and your loved ones. Ask God to deliver us from the evil one. Pray Ps. 143:10-12 as a prayer to God. Ask for God's full armor to be upon you and your loved ones.

The principle is to not follow the leading of the flesh but to walk according to the Spirit. We will be more protected in the center of God's will. Then also ask for protection. Jesus did.

To Love God First: that people in our communities, state and nation will rise up in righteousness and turn away from sin.

Unity of faith in Christ: that we will use our gifts in the body and that we will shine like the sun to unbelievers, to draw them to Christ; that God will protect us and break strongholds in our lives.

Leaders: of the nation to be convicted of sin, righteousness and guilt and for this country to be turned upside down for the glory of God.

Salvation for the Lost: that God will open their eyes and hearts to receive Christ.

Willingness of heart: Ask God to give you a willing heart to follow Him. (Isaiah 6:8)

Pour Out His Spirit on us: that God will change our hearts & loved ones with His Presence; & that we will be open to the way He desires to reveal Himself to us, for His glory!

Ministry: that we will all use our gifts effectively and be led by the Spirit.
